North Bay is nestled between two fresh water lakes which boast over 40 public beach access and breath-taking sunsets. The city provides a natural environment for, walking, cycling, hiking, boating, sailing, and golf.

North Bay is associated with the Dione Quintuplets which were born just on the outskirts of the city in 1934. They were the first quintuplets known to have survived their infancy.

During the cold war, a NORAD strategic operation centre was established in North Bay. The facility is 60 stories below ground to withstand a nuclear attack. The sister command centre is in Cheyenne Mountain near Colorado Springs, Colorado, US. Both facilities were staffed by Canadian and US armed forces personnel during the cold war.
